Preschool family storytimes help prepare your child for their preschool and kindergarten experiences in a group setting.

Children will enjoy books, songs, rhymes, and movement activities while building social, language, and literacy skills.

All storytimes are followed by a craft to help develop fine motor skills, as well as to reinforce the story themes.

MGOL lasts 15-20 minutes and is followed by creative play with puppets, books, and blocks.
